




## JOSLYN RECREATION CENTER NEWSLETTER

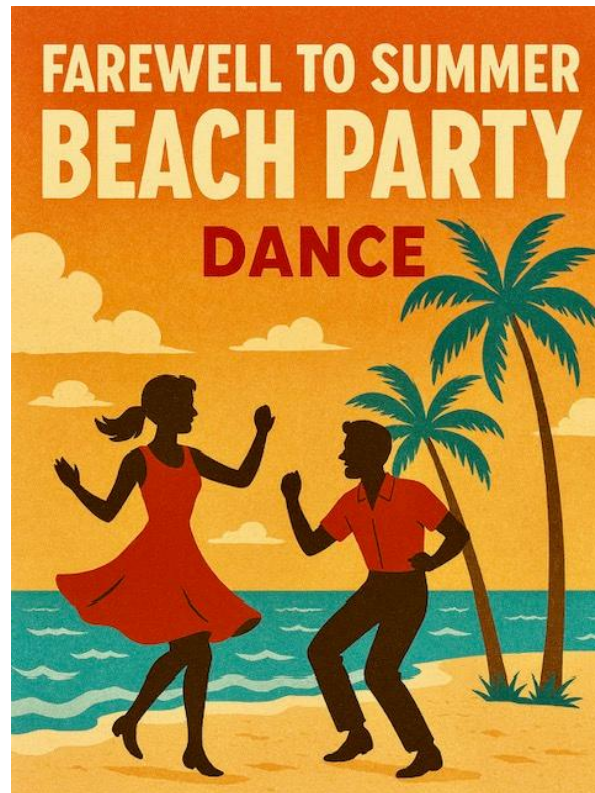
We finish with a short closing circle.
